The First Aid Team secures the first three links of the chain of survival up to the moment when the rescue services arrive at the scene.



We ensure security during internal and external school events.

During a potential evacuation of the building, the EHTK assists the school management and administration to guarantee a seamless execution.

Constant Training

The First Aiders meet on a weekly basis for theoretical and practical training sessions, they are supported and led by many partners such as the rescue services and medical professionals.

Every student of the Athénée's school community, from Seventh year to First Year, who has a First Aid Diploma, is welcome to join the team. To become an active member, we offer additional internal training.

During the first term of each school year, students have the opportunity to participate in a basic First Aid training course. This First Aid course is held in Luxembourgish or English by instructors from the Red Cross.

The EHTK – who are we?

The “Éischt Hëllef Team Kolléisich” – First Aid Team of the Athénée of Luxembourg – is a group of students from the Athénée (Kolléisich) who, in case of a medical emergency, can help their fellow students by performing first Aid.

The EHTK was founded in the school year 1998/1999 upon the initiative of the former vice-principal, Mr Paul Schilz. Initially, eight students volunteered under the guidance of Mr Henri Mousel to establish the First Aid Team, which grew to comprise over 40 active members in 2013/2014 when he retired.

Since January 2017, the EHTK counts 40 members, 38 of who are students. The IB is also represented. The Team is coordinated by the EHTK-committee, Mrs Myriam Gessner and Mr Jean-Louis Gindt as group leader.

In the First Aid Team, the students' philanthropy, autonomy and independence is fostered. Their proactive way of thinking is furthered through volunteering and they learn how to make decisions and take responsibility.

On-call service

The EHTK guarantees 3 on-call students per school lesson, who are on standby and who are alerted by pager in case of an emergency.



A well-equipped infirmary is at the disposal of the First Aid Team and every First Aider is naturally bound to secrecy.



In 2015 the EHTK was awarded the “Prix du Mérite Jeunesse” (part of The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award) in recognition of their project of “students helping students- learning First Aid with the First Aid Team of the Athénée”.

The EHTK's presence also ensures safety at all internal manifestations such as Kolléisich in Concert, the Charity Run and many others.



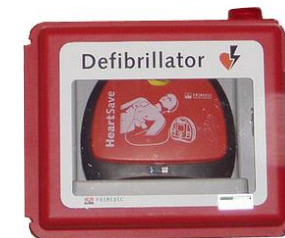
Mini Anne Project

In the context of their 10 year anniversary, the First Aid Team launched the Mini Anne Project. Initiated in 2009, the project ensures that every student from the 6e, 4e and 2e learns CPR on the Mini Anne training doll and the use of a defibrillator. Over 5000 students and teachers have already participated these training courses/workshops.



In collaboration with different partners, the EHTK also offers frequent Mini Anne Training courses and workshops in other schools or at various events (Télévie, Belle Etoile, etc.) As such, the EHTK works in close association with the LRC (Luxembourg Resuscitation Council).

AED – Automatic External Defibrillator



In 2009, the Athénée, was the first school in Luxembourg to install a defibrillator that is accessible to everyone.

The defibrillator is used in CPR and helps the First Aider in their efforts to save the victims.
